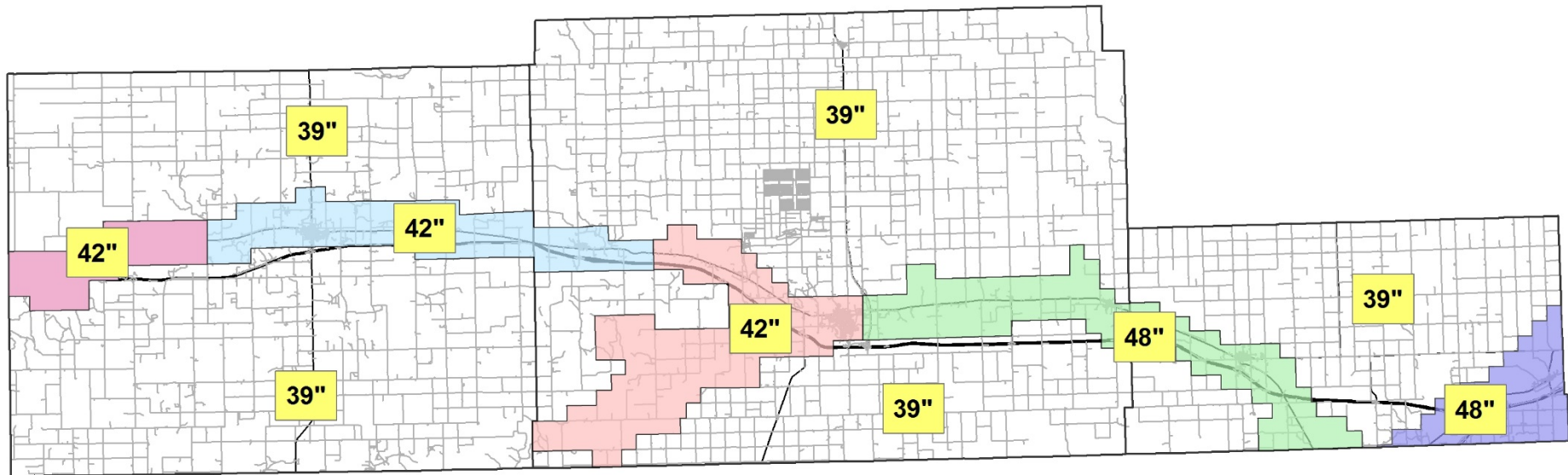

Comparison of 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017 to Historical Averages



